Town of Portugal Cove-St. Philip's

Policy to Allow Connections to Water Transmission Line by New and Existing Property Owners Along the Route

Pursuant to the authority conferred in Section 156 of the Municipalities Act, 1999 the Town Council of Portugal Cove-St. Philip's has adopted the following policy on the 22nd day of June, 2004.

1. <u>Title</u>

This document shall be known and cited as the *Policy to Allow Connections to Water Transmission Line by New and Existing Property Owners Along the Route.*

2. Policy Statement

This policy outlines the conditions necessary for connection to the Water transmission line by new developments and by existing property owners along the route.

3. Policy Clauses

Connection to Water transmission line is subject to:

- 3.1. Approval from the Department of Government Services verifying that the septic system is approved to allow connection to a piped water supply and additionally an approval from the Department of Environment.
- 3.2. Installation to comply with the Town's Water and Sewer Regulations and the servicing agreement.
- 3.3. That all costs associated with the installation would be the full responsibility of the property owner.
- 3.4. That the appropriate fees are paid to the Town with the Homeowner being responsible for the yearly water tax.
