Did you know that the following work requires a permit from the Town?

- Replacing Siding, Doors and Windows;
- Constructing Patios/Decks;
- Replacing Shingles/Roofs;
- Performing Minor Landscaping with the use of Heavy Equipment, and;
- External Repairs to Existing Structures.

General Repairs & Maintenance Permits expire 6 months from the date of issuance.

# Emergency Planning Safety Tips



- MAKE a home escape plan. Draw a map of your home showing all doors and windows.
   Discuss the plan with everyone in your home.
- KNOW at least two ways out of every room, if possible. Make sure all doors and windows leading outside open easily.
- HAVE an outside meeting place (like a tree, light pole or mailbox) a safe distance from the home where everyone should meet.
- PRACTICE your home fire drill at night and during the day with everyone in your home, twice a year

- PRACTICE using different ways out
- TEACH children how to escape on their own in case you can't help them
- CLOSE doors behind you as you leave

#### IF THE ALARM SOUNDS...

- If the smoke alarm sounds, GET OUT AND STAY OUT. Never go back inside for people or pets.
- If you have to escape through smoke, GET LOW AND GO under the smoke on your way out.
- CALL the fire department from outside your home
