The PCSP Volunteer Fire Department has recently been through a significant shift within its organizational walls. The Department has experienced a move into a different way of viewing both itself, and how the organization views its role within the community of Portugal Cove-St. Philip's. During the process of a self-introduced organizational assessment, the organization recognized the opportunity and the advantages of a new crest, to lead us in the coming years.

This new crest's design and creation was done by the hand of Lieutenant Chris Donovan, who is involved in the graphic arts industry. Chris created a number of different crests for the fire department's membership to assess and revise in order to arrive at a collaboratively developed crest. This crest was chosen as the best, and most accurately reflected image, of our membership. This crest gives the Town of Portugal Cove-St. Philip's Fire Department a truly reflective image that holds both new aspects and traditional images.

The Iron Cross has been the symbol of the fire service for many years. Contained within the cross is Newfoundland Flag, along with our community name. Also included, is our main area supporting our purpose of Fire & Rescue, along with the traditional crossed fire axes. Finally, the Maple Leaf completes the crest and all of these components make this crest both very unique and also very proudly supported.

This crest will be posted on our Fire Stations, hung inside our classrooms in both stations, worn by our membership and posted on our fire apparatuses.

The membership of the Portugal Cove-St. Philip's Volunteer Fire Department stands very proud at the opportunity to serve our community.

Summer Program Registration June 9th

The Town of Portugal Cove - St. Philip's will be holding registration for Summer Programs on Thursday June 9^{th} , 2011 at the Town Hall from 4:30 pm-6:30pm. This year the Program will run from July 4^{th} - August 26^{th} (please note there is no program July $18^{\text{th}}-22^{\text{nd}}$ due to the Killick Coast Games). Due to limited spaces, registration is on a first come-first serve basis, spots will not be held before payment is made. (**Parents must pay up front for all registered days. Post dated cheques or post dated credit card information WILL be accepted**).

In order to make registration run as smooth as possible we ask parents to keep the following items in mind:

- Ø We encourage parents to bring cash or post dated cheques to registration to limit wait times as debit machine takes longer.
- Ø We encourage parents to fill out the required registration and medical forms beforehand. The required forms can be found on the Town's website at www.pcsp.ca
- Ø MCP number will be required at registration.
- Ø There is an extra cost for Thursdays as kids go swimming at the Aquarena. This is an additional \$3.25 that must be paid up front (ie: if your child is registered for all 7 weeks and plans on swimming every Thursday you must pay \$22.75 extra).

The Kinderskills Program is for children ages 4-6 years old (kids must be entering kindergarten in September or have just finished this June) Kinderskills will provide children with the opportunity to develop communication skills and become accustomed to peer interaction, while engaging in fun and creative, physical and artistic activities. This year we will run from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm on Tuesday and Thursday's with an early drop off at 8:00am and a late pick up at 5:00pm.
