# **Resolutions – Writing Tips**

**Prepared by the MNL Advocacy Committee** 

Our people · Our place · Our potential

As an association representing all municipalities in Newfoundland and Labrador, having resolutions that are provincial in scope are better for the advocacy process. A good resolution is detailed and factual and includes clear, concise wording. Understanding the issue as presented in the operative clause is imperative to ensure that MNL's advocacy efforts are focused on the intent of the resolution. This document outlines the required components that must be included in a resolution for consideration by the MNL Advocacy.

**Title:** The title should give a clear indication of the resolution's intent. It should, at a glance, provide the reader an understanding of the topic matter and the desired outcome. (Example: Remove Boll Water Advisories in a Timeller Manner)

**Preamble (aka 'Whereas' clause):** The preamble provides context for the resolution. It concisely identifies the situation or environment prompting the resolution, as well as its impact or significance. Where practical, include:

- The source of your facts
- · References to the specific legislation affected by or causing the problem
- · Past resolutions or current lobby efforts on the same subject
- Recent incidents or developments

**Operative Clause (aka 'Therefore be it resolved' clause):** There are two main kinds of resolutions: *policy and directive*. A policy states the opinion of the group. A directive is a call to action. Consider the result you want and phrase the resolution accordingly. The operative clause should be succinct and complete. In isolation from the preamble and background, the reader should understand the resolution's intent exactly. These clauses can contain the following aspects:

- Recommendations for specific action
- Statements of opinions
- Requests for further consideration or monitoring
- Formation of a committee
- Writing a letter to key stakeholders
- Making a formal request
- Bringing a matter to the attention of key stakeholders, etc.

**Member Background:** The member background section provides in-depth information on the context and environment. Fundamentally, it includes and expands on all the relevant information contained in the preamble, such as:

- History of the issue
- References to specific legislation
- · Past resolutions or current lobby efforts by MNL or other relevant organizations
- Recent incidents or developments
- Issue impacts, both positive and negative
- Identifying others stakeholders with a vested interest
- Supportive publications

# **Nomination Process**

# Q. What is the Municipal Assessment Agency?

A. The Municipal Assessment Agency is the corporation responsible for providing real property valuations for property tax purposes under the Assessment Act. A ten member Board governs the Agency, comprising six elected municipal officials, two taxpayer representatives, and a representative each of the MNL and PMA. The municipal clients elect the six municipal representatives. The remaining nominees are appointed by either the provincial government or their representative group.

## Q. Who can run for the Board?

- A. Any elected municipal official is eligible to be nominated provided they meet some basic requirements. The municipality they serve must be a client of the municipality whose account is not more than ninety days in arrears. The individual must be a member of council and must meet the criteria provided by the Corporations Act, namely the individual must:
  - a) be nineteen years of age or older
  - b) not be mentally incompetent or has been found so by a court in Canada or elsewhere
  - c) not have the status of a bankrupt.

An individual councillor is eligible to be nominated as the director for the grouping to which their municipality belongs.

## Q. What is the deadline for nominations?

A. Nominations will close 4:00 PM NST on October 26, 2017. Only nominations received at the office of the Agency's Executive Director at that time will be considered. Nomination forms can be faxed or mailed, but will not be accepted after 4:00 PM NST on October 26, 2017. Ballots will be distributed by November 1, 2017 and the election period will close on December 14, 2017.

# Q. What is the term of the Board? Is there any compensation?

A. Board members will be elected for a four year term and the successful candidates will serve until December 31, 2021. An honorarium is paid and all reasonable expenses associated with Board activities are reimbursed in accordance with the Agency's policy.
