Regatta Postponed, Canada Day Events Ago
Traditional Dory Boat Regatta to Take Place Next Weekend

Due to impending weather, the Town of Portugal Cove-St. Philip's regatta has been postponed from the original date of Saturday, June 30th and will now take place on Saturday, July 7th. The St. Philip's Boat Launch will now be open on June 30th, and closed for the regatta on July 7th.

The Community Breakfast will go ahead as planned on Saturday, June 30th at 9am at the Legion. Canada Day celebrations will go ahead (rain or shine) on Sunday, July 1st. These celebrations are scheduled to take place at Rainbow Gully Park, however in the event of rain, the Canada Day festivities will take place nearby at Brookside Intermediate.
