Week-long Canada Day & Regatta Festival

Celebration and Community Events to Take Place in Portugal Cove St. Philip's

Each year, the Town of Portugal Cove-St. Philip's hosts a week of exciting community events for people of all ages! The 2018 Canada Day and Regatta Festival runs from June 30th-July 7th. Throughout the week, those who attend the festival can take in a range of daily events, including a regatta, carnival, parade, movies, fitness, arts, and crafts.

One of the most highly anticipated festival events is the regatta, which takes place on Saturday June 30th from 12pm-5pm at the St. Philip's Marina. Unlike many other regattas in this province, to row in the Portugal Cove-St. Philip's regatta no prior experience is needed and rowers use traditional Newfoundland-style dories. Those wishing to try rowing in the regatta can simply come by the event and register for a race upon arrival. A brand new fleet of three dories was constructed this spring at a workshop hosted by the Town and the Wooden Boat Museum of Newfoundland. These new dories will be christened and then rowed for the first time at the regatta on Saturday.
