Fire Safety <u>During Winter</u> Storms

Winter storms are a regular part of the season in this province. Being prepared before, during and after the storm can make a big difference and help keep you and your family safe.

- Test your smoke alarms at least once a month and install carbon monoxide alarms.
- Plan two ways out of the house in case of emergency and keep the exits and driveway clear of ice and snow.
- Make sure your house number is easily seen from the roadway.
- Be ready for power outages and use extreme caution if you use candles.
- Be aware of winter weather and watch for bulletins.
- Check on your neighbors and others who may need help.
- Generators should be used outdoors and away from windows and doors. Never run a generator in your garage.
- Stay away from downed wires and report them to authorities asap.
- Be ready for loss of heat, and if you use an emergency heat source, keep flammable items at least 1 meter away.
- Never leave a portable heater running when you are not in the room. Turn them off when you go to bed.
- Keep chimneys clean and free of debris like creosote, nests, snow and ice. Have your chimney cleaned and inspected at least once a year.

IMPORTANT REMINDER:

There are more home fires in winter than in any other season. Half of all home heating fires happen in December, January and February.

As you stay cozy and warm this winter season, be fire smart!

SNOW CLEARING REGULATIONS

WINTER PARKING BAN:

As a means of continuing the Town of Portugal Cove-St. Philip's commitment to public safety, the winter parking ban will come into effect on November 1st, 2019 through to April 30th, 2020. During this time there will be no parking on the street reservation between 12:00 midnight and 8:00am, as well as any time there is a snowfall event including the twelve hours immediately following the event. This ban is enacted to facilitate the safe and orderly flow of traffic, emergency services, and to protect pedestrians within our community during snow removal operations.

SNOW CLEARING:

In the interest of public safety, residents are also reminded that during the winter parking ban snow and ice cannot be shoveled, blown, or plowed into the street. Doing so also hinders snow removal operations.

CLIMATE CHANGE PROJECTS IN OUR TOWN

Climate Change is such a hot topic these days and when it comes to the environment, ACE and the Town strive to be leaders. As a Town, we are currently working on 3 climate change projects that will help our Town Council make decisions and changes with the changing climate and future in mind. All 3 projects are funded through FCM (Federation of Canadian Municipalities). These projects have been undergoing several meetings with climate change representatives, Town Councilors, Directors, and staff, as well as local stakeholders including the Chamber of Commerce, ACE, and the PCSP Heritage Committee.

CCNL (Conservation Corps NL) is conducting one of the projects. This one is a provincially based project, of which PCSP is one of 6 municipalities participating. By working through the province's "7 Steps to Assess Climate Change Vulnerability in Your Community" resource guide, we have identified the types of climate and weather related issues that have affected the Town, including location and what infrastructure could be impacted, as well as residents in areas who have been or will be most affected and how the natural environment and economic sectors could be affected.

ICLEI Canada has been working closely with us on another project to identify climate impacts, assess vulnerability and risk assessment and develop community-wide adaptation strategies. For this project we are one of 8 municipalities across Canada that were selected to participate. CBS is also participating from our province.

We have also received funding that has allowed us to hire a Climate Change Coordinator on a 2-year funded contract through MCIP (Municipalities for Climate Innovation Program). As a result of this funding, the Town has committed to Climate Change Mitigation action by enrolling in the PCP (Partners for Climate Protection) Program. The Town has been undertaking a corporate greenhouse gas inventory, which will be followed by a community-wide greenhouse gas inventory in the coming months. The corporate inventory will allow the Town to assess where emissions reductions and cost savings could occur.
