- Safety scissors

#### Gather your supplies.

Cut a small section of straw and run your string through the center.

Tie the string to opposite ends of the room.

Blow up your balloon to tape it onto the straw on the string. Don 't tie a knot.

Hold the balloon at one end of the sting and let it fly! Challenge your family to set up their racers too! Who's balloon went the farthest?

If you use a different shape balloon, will the balloon travel farther?

If you make tie the string higher on one end to make a hill, will the balloon fly just as far?
