### Responsibilities

- Rentals of snowshoes
- Cleaning upon returns
- Keeping building organized
- Trail Condition Checks – checking trails in morning, and throughout the day for weather conditions
- Trail Use Inspections – checking on participants renting snowshoes throughout the day
- Site Maintenance

- Ability to exercise sound judgment and discretion in decision making
- Well-developed interpersonal and organizational skills;
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team;
- Time management skills and ability to set priorities
- Customer Service experience is an asset

- Applicants should be completing Level II, III or finished high school
