

Materials:

- A tinfoil "Pie tin" or something similar that can hold water and materials. A tinfoil bowl works best as it can be bent to get frozen suncatcher out.
- A piece of string.
- Small bits of nature.
- Water.



Instructions

- Gather the pieces of nature (Berries, Twigs, Flowers, etc).
- Place the items into your bowl. Leaving the string half hanging out.



- Fill up with water until everything is covered. Important to have the string hanging outside of the bowl.
- Place in your freezer overnight.



• Once frozen, pop the suncatcher out carefully and then hang your ice suncatcher outside!
