WINTER PARKING BAN

Residents are reminded that during the period from November 1st, 2022 to April 30th, 2023 both days inclusive, no person shall park, leave, or abandon any vehicle or any portion of any vehicle upon any Street Reservation within the Town between the hours of 12:00 midnight to and including 8:00 am; and at any time when there is a snowfall and for 12 HOURS after the snowfall has ceased. Vehicles left on the roadway may be subject to a ticket or be impounded at the owner's expense.

The 2023 Waste Collection schedule was mailed out to residents and is also available on our website! Residents are encouraged to download the schedule to refer all year long. Here are some friendly reminders for waste collection:

- 1. During Winter months, ensure your waste containers are **clear of snow and ice** so our crews can access them.
- 2. Have bags for pick-up? Place your bags outside by **8:30am** to ensure our crews pick up your items in time.
- As the Spring season begins, remove any debris surrounding your waste containers and inside them. This will reduce unwanted wild life making a home in them

Winter in Newfoundland can bring a mixed bag of weather, that changes at any moment. Here are some friendly tips that to combat Winter weather in PCSP:

- 1. Wear **reflective clothing** so our snow clearing crews can see you, it can get blistery out there!
- 2. Watch our **social media and website** for updates; changes and updates to waste collection, closures and program are posted first on our website and social media pages.
- 3. Sign up for **PCSP Connects**, our residential alert system. Be notified of changes in waste collection, weather, programming, events and so much more! Sign up on our website so you don't miss a notification.
- 4. Use **markers** at the end of your driveway.
- **5. Clear off your waste boxes** so our pick-up crews can see what's to be collected.

ANNUAL TAX LEVY TIME!

Tax Levy Invoices were mailed during the **first week of January 2023**. If you have not received your tax bill, please contact **ar@pcsp.ca**.

- Property owner(s) are responsible for ensuring the Town has their current mailing address on file.
- Property owner(s) are responsible for understanding their tax and interest obligations regardless of any error in the issuance of notification from the Town.
- Deadline for payment is March 31.
- Taxes not paid in full by the due date, are subject to a one percent (1%) compounded interest rate which will be applied on the first day of every month.
- Accounts with a balance forward in January for the prior year's taxes, may be subject to collection measures, recovery and legal action.
