- Brookside Intermediate: blue zone and stall parking are available, but do not park in the area highlighted in red in the map; this area must be kept clear for emergency access. Canteen services are available in the cafeteria, cash only.


- Blue zone and stall parking are available in Voisey's Brook Park.

First Aid and Parking Map







Equipment Required

Ball Hockey

- Players must supply their own helmets, gloves and sticks.
- Shinpads are highly recommended.
- Goalie gear can be provided by the Town (full face helmet, chest protector, pads, blocker, glove, jersey, stick); persons are encouraged to bring their own if able.

Basketball

• Pinnies will be provided as needed.

Soccer

• Players must wear cleats (no metal), shin pads and socks.

Softball

- Helmets will be provided by the Town of Portugal Cove St. Philip's
- Bats will be provided by the Town of Portugal Cove St. Philip's (**NO** outside/player owned bats permitted).
- Catcher gear will be provided by the Town of Portugal Cove St. Philip's (teams may bring their own).

• The Killick Coast Games will run from Sunday, July 28th to Thursday August 1st

Where are the Killick Coast Games Located?

- All games will be played in Rainbow Gully Park or Brookside Intermediate School (Basketball Only)
- Voiseys Brook Park will be the location of the Cross-Country Run.

Will I be allowed to Watch my Child Participate?

- Yes! Spectator are welcome to come watch any of the games.
- We ask that all spectators be respectful and courteous to all players, referees, staff, volunteers, and parents throughout the week.

Will my Child be Provided Food During the Week?

- If your child is a registered participant, they will receive a meal card as part of their athlete packages. This will give them 2 snacks, a meal and a drink item during each day of the games.
- Additional food can be purchased from the canteen.
- Athletes are encouraged to bring additional food/drink items with them if needed.

Will there be First Aid Available?

- Yes. We will have a designated site at each location for First Aid.
- In the event of an emergency, please call 911 and let one of our staff members know.

Will there be parking?

• Yes, parking is available but is limited. Parking can be viewed in the maps below.

• We encourage carpooling if parties are able.
