Eligibility Criteria

To apply, you must:

- Be a current resident of Portugal Cove-St. Philip's (PCSP), NL.
- Be legally entitled to work according to provincial and federal regulations.
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or a person with refugee status in Canada.
- Meet the minimum academic entrance requirements for the chosen program.
- Demonstrate a positive community impact, such as volunteer work in the healthcare field.

Selection Process

Initial Screening:

All applications will be reviewed for completeness and eligibility.

Review by Scholarship Committee:

Applications will be evaluated based on the personal statement, letters of recommendation, academic achievements, and community involvement.

Final Selection:

The winner will be selected and notified by August 19, 2024.

Scholarship Winner:

- Must be 17 years of age by the start of the selected program.
- Must meet all entrance requirements for the program of choice.

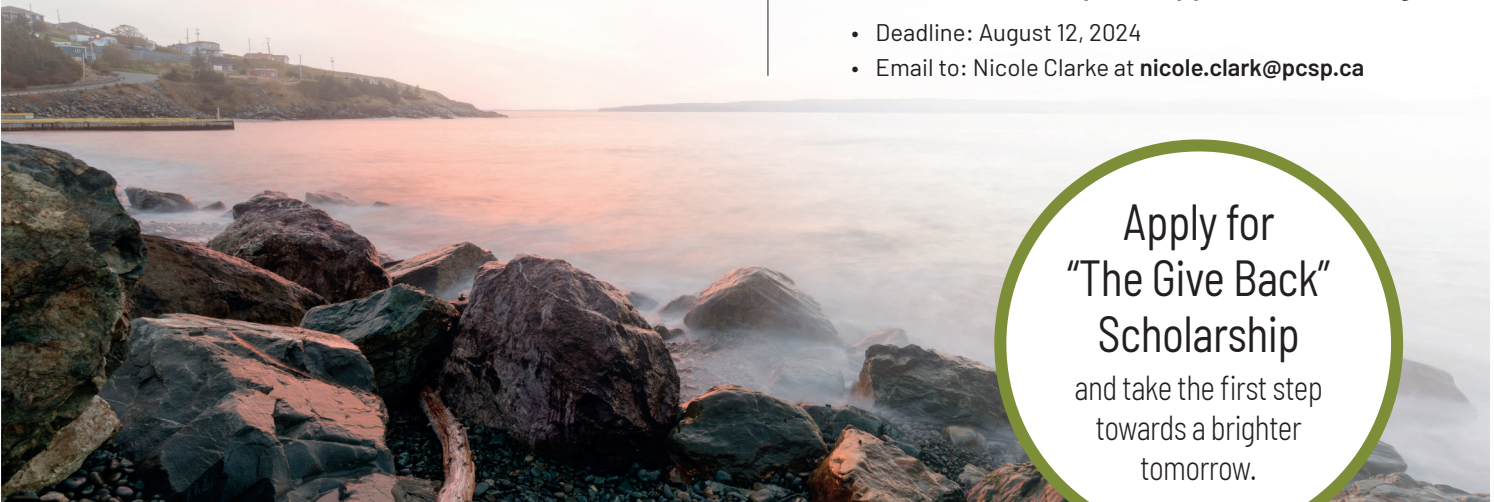

- Personal Statement (500-700 words): Discuss your educational goals, community service involvement, experience living in PCSP, leadership contributions, and career aspirations.
- Two Letters of Recommendation:
 - One from a teacher or academic advisor.
 - One from a community leader or volunteer supervisor.
- Additional Documents:
 - Academic Transcript
 - Proof of Residency in PCSP
 - Resume highlighting your education, work experience, and volunteer activities.
