The Town of Portugal Cove – St. Philip's is seeking a Water & Wastewater Maintenance 1 (Field) within the Public Works Department. We are seeking a reliable, enthusiastic individual who understands the importance of health and safety in the workplace. This position may involve hours of work outside the normal working hours as per Article 16:01(e) of the Collective Agreement. The Town is an equal opportunity employer.

Qualifications:

- Post-secondary training, in the area of water/wastewater, electrical or instrumentation.
- Completion of courses from the Provincial Operator Education, Training and Certification program would be considered an asset.
- Experience with water and wastewater infrastructure, pumps, valves, and treatment systems.
- Must possess or have the ability to obtain confined space, fall arrest, hazardous materials and gas detection training, as well as other OHS training as required.
- Must possess Class 5 driver's license valid in the province of Newfoundland & Labrador.
- High school diploma or equivalency.
- Experience in municipal environment considered an asset.
- Must be capable of being insured, and maintaining continuity, under the Town's driver insurance policy.

Knowledge, Skills, & Abilities:

- Knowledge of and experience in the operation and maintenance of water and wastewater infrastructure.
- Proficient computer skills.
- Basic electrical skills.
- Skilled in mechanical repair.
- Repair and maintenance skills.
- Skilled in the safe operation of light duty tools and equipment.
- Ability to clearly communicate information both verbally and in writing.
- Ability to establish and maintain a professional effective working relationship with other departments and to interact with all levels of employees, Town officials and the public.
- Ability to exercise sound judgment and discretion in decision making.
- Excellent troubleshooting and problem solving skills.
- Ability to understand and follow complex written and oral instructions.
- Ability to work well in a team environment and able to support a work environment based on cooperation and respect.

Physical Requirements:

- While performing the essential functions of this position, there is frequent need to sit, stand, walk, talk, hear, distinguish between shades of color, use hands to finger, handle, or feel, and lift and/or move 20 pounds.
- While performing the essential functions of this position in the field, there is potential for exposure to disagreeable environmental factors, such as outside weather conditions, dampness/humidity, vehicular traffic, toxic/caustic substances, fumes, and odors.
- Tasks involve the intermittent performance of extremely physically demanding work, typically involving some combination of reaching, bending, stooping, kneeling, crouching, climbing, and that may involve the lifting, carrying, pushing, and/or pulling of heavy objects (50-100 pounds).
- Entry into confined spaces using appropriate safety equipment and ability to maneuver within confined space area, which may include twisting, crouching, reaching, pushing, pulling and crawling.
