Anyone interested in rowing a traditional Newfoundland dory boat is welcome to attend the free Portugal Cove-St. Philip's Rowing Open House! There is no experience needed and all those ages 16+ are encouraged to try the new boats. The fleet of three new dories was constructed this spring during the Town's Wooden Boat Building Workshop in partnership with the Wooden Boat Museum of Newfoundland.

The Rowing Open House precedes the PCSP Regatta, which is set to take place on Saturday, June 30th. Anyone can row in the regatta and it is not mandatory to attend the rowing open house to row in the regatta races. Regatta Day is a part of the 2018 Canada Day and Regatta Festival, which is a week of fun-filled community events from June 30th-July 7th in Portugal Cove-St. Philip's.
